

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972

It is the policy of California State University, East Bay ("CSUEB") to comply with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and its regulations, which prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex, including sexual harassment. To that end, CSUEB is committed to resolving, in a prompt, equitable and impartial manner, all reports and complaints of sex-based discrimination and sexual harassment it receives.

The Title IX Compliance Officer is the Director of Equity and Diversity. Currently, that individual is Linda Nolan. She has been appointed to coordinate and carry out the University's responsibilities under Title IX.
